She feels it is easy to shop online than shop at a physical store like other people in her generation.

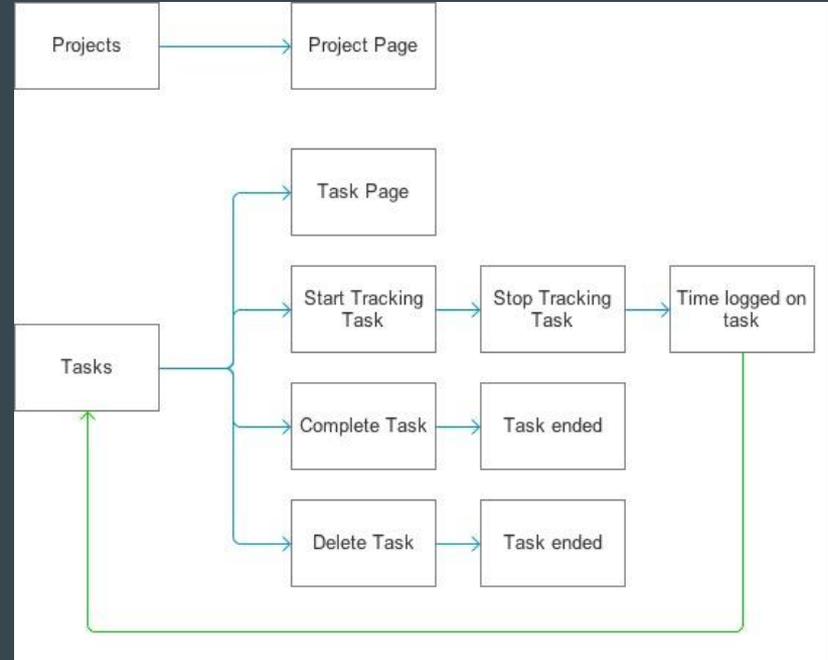
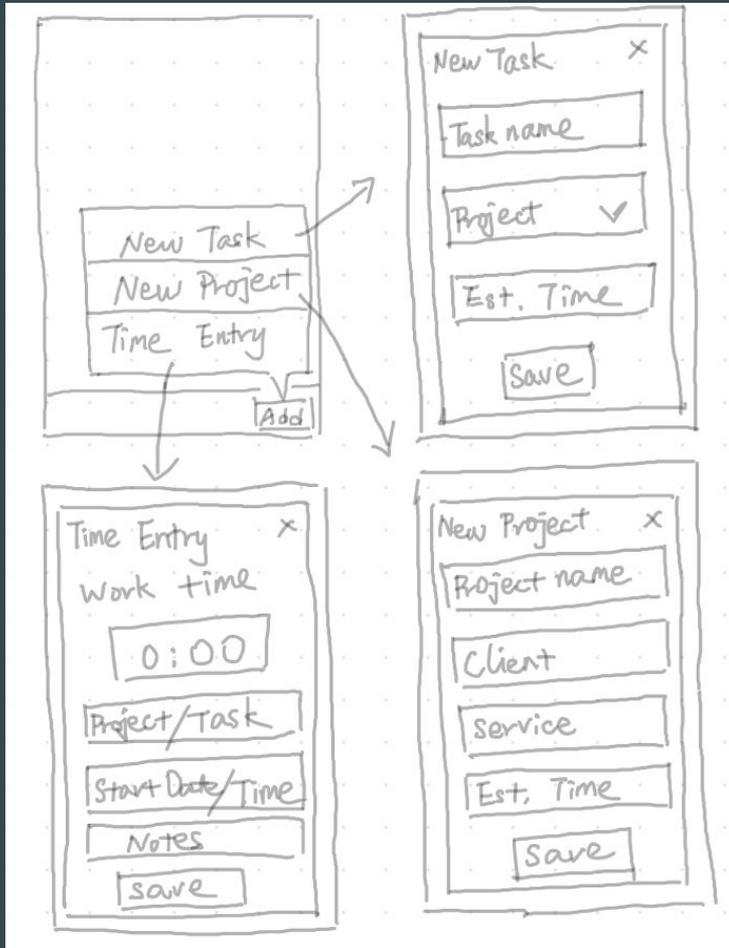
Scenarios

She opens her app store and search for “good time tracking app” and find some top rated tracking apps. She looks through the app reviews before she decides whether she should download or not.

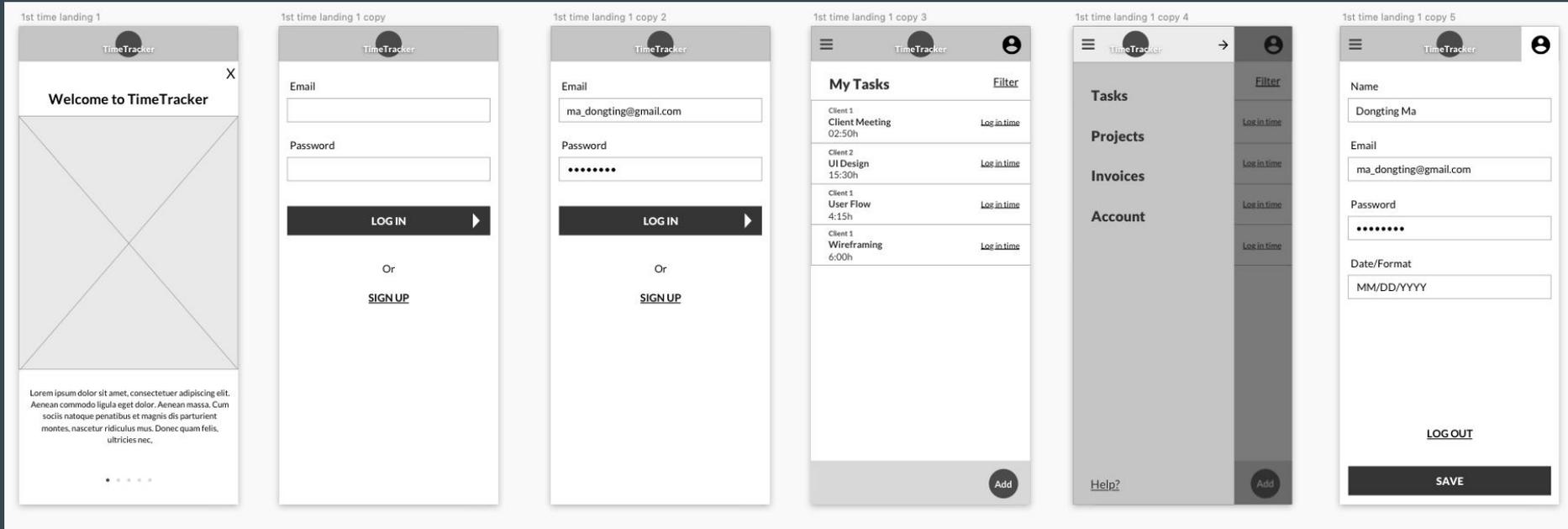

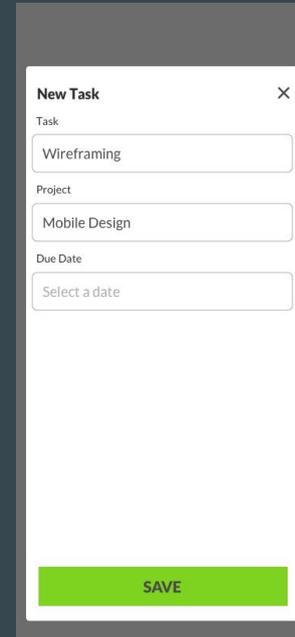
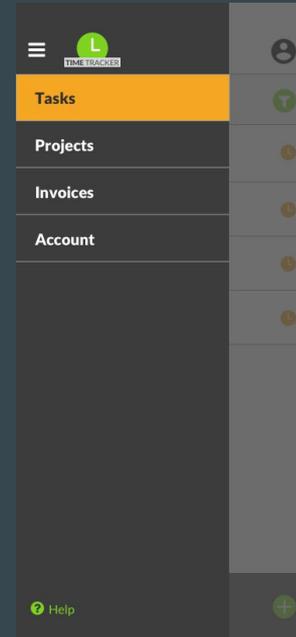
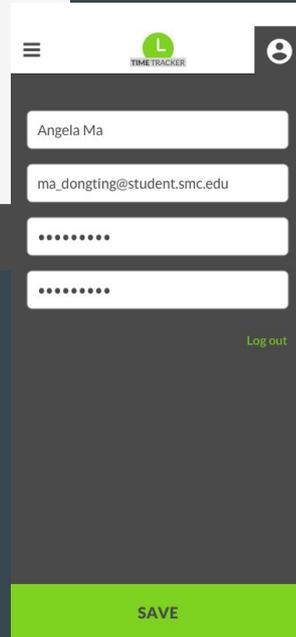
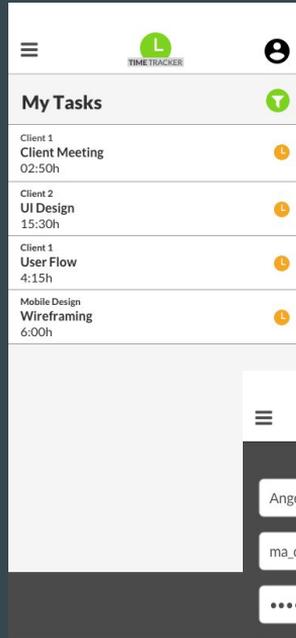
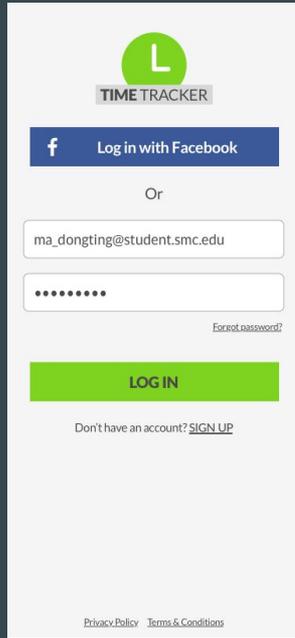
Developing structure and visual language through preliminary sketching and flow chart
